




- · MEASURE SPACE + SKETCH SITE OUTLINE
- · TRY LAYOUTS FOR FIT (SUGGEST SCALE 1:100)
- KEEP AWAY FROM WALLS + FIXED OBJECTS
- · 2-WAY STREETS = 4'-6' WIDE
- · 1-WAY STREETS = 3'-4' WIDE
- · ROUNDABOUTS = 1-WAY, COUNTERCLOCKWISE
- · INSIDE BENDS/CORNERS = 3'+ RADIUS
- · ARROWS FOR SIDES & DIRECTION
- · FINALIZE DESIGN + ADD DETAILS








Installing Your DIY Traffic Garden.

KEEP LAYOUT HANDY FOR REFERENCE





- 3. ROUGHLY LOCATE STREETS + INTERSECTIONS
- 4. START MEASURING FROM LAYOUT CENTER OR KEY INTERSECTION
- 5. ESTABLISH STREET CORNER LOCATIONS



1. SWEEP DEBRIS & SMALL PEBBLES AWAY




- 7. MARK STREET WIDTH AT POINTS ALONG **LENGTHS**
- 8. STAND BACK TO SEE IF LAYOUT ADJUSTMENTS NEEDED . .





- 9. MARK OUT ENTIRE LAYOUT BEFORE ADDING IN FINAL STREET LINES
- 10. ADD STREET LINES USING SIDEWALK CHALK OR SPRAY CHALK OR DUCT TAPE





- 11. USE YARD STICKS TO KEEP STRAIGHT LINES & MAINTAIN WIDTHS
- 17. ADD CROSSWALKS, STOP BARS, RAILROAD LINES & MARKINGS









TIPS FOR USING SPRAY CHALK

- ▼ Test how chalk applies & dries beforehand
- ▼ For crisp lines, use templates or painter's tape
- ✓ Parallel painter's tape lines with 2" gap. between + spray = long street lines
- ✓ Spray lightly 6"-12" from surface
- ✓ Use cardboard to prevent overspray beyond template
- ✓ Use foam brush to push extra chalk into the corners
- ▼ Wait for chalk to dry before moving template
- ▼ Wipe off the template between uses
- ✓ Fix mistakes with water spray + scrubbing brush
- ▼ For longer-lasting sidewalk chalk, 'fix' with hair spray

DRAWING CORNER OR ROUNDABOUT

- ▼ Tie string securely around sidewalk chalk + other end to rock
- ▼ Wrap string around rock until it is size of radius & place rock at radius start point
- ✓ Stretch string firmly while holding chalk upright
- ✓ Draw chalk quarter circle for corner or full circle for roundabout
